

### Caring for the most vulnerable

- Supported a hosting scheme for 50 single mothers, disabled and elder people on Lesvos
- Created a hub for refugee and migrant women in Athens
- Provided mental health support to more than 650 refugees with post-trauma disorder and mental health disorders
- Establishing food voucher projects for 100 Greek, settled migrants and people on the move, families, based on vulnerability
- Assisted presence in 7 frontline islands providing health and legal services, during the outbreak of the refugee emergency
- Facilitated monitoring of all detention centers in N.Greece, Korinthos and Amygdaleza

### Breaking the glass

- Supported the first microcredit scheme for new enterpreneurs in Greece
- Supported 40 Roma children in Xanthi for educational support classes
- Assisted 18 new social enterprises and cooperatives during their kick-off phase
- Assisted 30 young people with disabilities with integration in social life activities
- Operating a helpline provided psychosocial support to more than 300 LGBT+ people and their families and supported two pro LGBT rights campaigns
